 - from Ikebukuro station : JR Saikyo line to Jujo, then walk 5 mins.
 - from Tokyo station : JR Keihin Tohoku Line to Higashi Jujo, then walk 10 mins.

Accommodation

ISPA2018 Local Organizing Committee offers opportunity to reserve some nearby hotels to the attendants through the ISPA registration webpage. Prices of the hotel rooms blocked by ISPA, range from 8,000 to 20,000 Japanese Yen for one person (tax included) per night. They are mostly single rooms, and some twin rooms, located around the nearby local stations.

One's individual searches on the Internet may, or may not, find some lower prices for rooms at the same hotels, but that depends on each hotel's monthly offers. We can't predict whether there will be any such offers, or vacancies at all, at this time. Other forms of accommodation, including traditional, Japanese-style "ryokan", as well as shared hostel rooms or dormitory, may also be found by searching the Internet.
